Language Courses

A basic knowledge of English (at least two years in school) is obligatory for students just starting to learn German. Participants will be divided into three teaching groups after sitting a placement test on the first day. Students in our beginners' group will cover basic language skills and a priority will be given to conversation.

Intermediate students will read and discuss newspaper articles, short stories, and play scenes. To improve their knowledge of grammar and expand their vocabulary, they will read challenging and engaging texts and discuss current topics covered in recent newspapers.

Advanced students will be encouraged – with the support of their teachers – to compose essays and reports on different topics discovered in newspapers or literary texts.

All students also contribute to the course magazine they take home at the end of the programme. All German teachers are native speakers with many years of teaching experience in both German and German as a foreign language. Maximum size of any course group is 12 students.
